2011 Marketplace Information & Rules of Participation

- Upon arrival, participants must check in with the registration tent prior to setting up.
- **Set-up begins at 5 p.m. on Friday, May 6th and 7:30 a.m. on Saturday, May 7th.** Early set up is unfortunately not available due to downtown business traffic. Tear down is immediately following event's end. No early pack-up is allowed.
- Outdoor spaces are a maximum of 10' X 10'. Most booth locations will be on pavement. If your merchandise is breakable and you require a booth on grass, you must indicate on application. A few grass locations are available.
- If you plan to set up Friday evening, you must indicate on application. There is no additional charge. This is for planning purposes only.
- Booth space location will be determined due to date of receipt of application and entry fee and will be assigned by event staff. Participants cannot relocate without permission from event chairperson.
- Every effort will be made to divide booths into merchandise categories. Vendors selling handmade arts, crafts and merchandise will be located closest to parade route.
- All product categories must be listed on application
- Only products listed on your application will be allowed for sale. The Tennessee Iris Festival asks that participants bring only items that are deemed appropriate for a family oriented event. The event chairperson reserves the right to request the removal of questionable merchandise. The following specific items will not be allowed: fireworks, Confederate flags, silly string, spray paints of any kind.
- Participants can share a booth if indicated on application
- Event will be held rain or shine. Canopy tents are allowed provided they fit in designated booth space. **Outdoor lighting, other than street lamps, is not provided by the festival.**
- A hospitality booth will be staffed and available to participants at the following times: Friday 7-8 p.m. & Saturday 10 a.m. -12 p.m.
- Participants are responsible for Tennessee State Sales Tax.
- Items may be left on-site only at the risk of the participants. The Tennessee Iris Festival, City of Dresden and chairpersons are not responsible for any losses or injuries.
- Trash must be removed from your space to provided receptacles.
- No refunds or show credits.
